

Walking safely

10 things to remember for a tip top trek



1. Make sure you can be seen



Don't put yourself at risk by walking close to cattle



3. Walk facing traffic if there is no pavement

Don't walk too close behind a horse and its rider and give them a wide berth when overtaking on foot

7. Never assume a driver sees you - make eye contact with drivers to make sure you are seen

8. Follow the rules of the road and obey signs and signals
